



(or the process of cultivating the site as a thought experiment)



works with the phenomenon of room-tone as a unique sound base for each space. On the floor of the falconry, she recorded samples of silence, which intensified in postproduction and gave them a resonance effect to dilute some of the dry noise generated by the recording equipment itself. She then set up six hidden speakers in the attic, reproducing the sound of loud silence. The installation was accompanied by a man on his way to a large rafter space situated above the gym itself, to which he was connected by metal lighting covers that resonantly transmit the sounds of life and movement down in the gymnasium. It was an expression of the fragile symbiotic relationship between the old building and the people who use it, through the deep silence that at one point gives way to sounds generated by humans in real time.
